

What does the Allergy Seal of Quality on the packaging of food products mean?

The Allergy Seal of Quality is a certification standard identifying products that are suitable for people suffering from allergies and intolerances.

With clear and measurable criteria, Service Allergie Suisse checks what is not contained in the product.



The Allergy Seal of Quality stands for strict quality standards and regular controls. This ensures that the products always meet the requirements of Service Allergie Suisse.

The Allergy Seal of Quality reassures consumers suffering from allergies and intolerances that the products they buy are safe for them.



What does the Allergy Seal of Quality on the packaging of cosmetic products mean?

The Allergy Seal of Quality is a certification standard that identifies products suitable for people with allergy-prone and sensitive skin.

If a cosmetic product with the Allergy Seal of Quality is advertised as "without perfume" or "without fragrance", it must not contain any natural or synthetic fragrances. No plant extracts may be used for perfuming either.



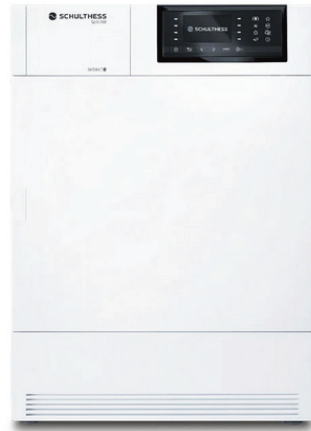

The Allergy Seal of Quality gives people with sensitive or allergy-prone skin confidence that the products they buy are safe for them.



What does the Allergy Seal of Quality for household appliances mean?

The Allergy Seal of Quality is a certification standard that labels products suitable for people with allergies (e.g. pollen, dust mite, mould and animal allergies). The allergy(s) for which the product is suitable is indicated on the packaging.



For washing systems: a washing system for allergy-causing particles must achieve an efficiency of at least 60 % during a wash cycle for particles of 0.4 μ m.

For filter systems: a filter system must achieve an efficiency of at least 50% for particles of 0.3-1.0 μ m over the entire service life. Standard 1822:1-2019 applies to HEPA filters.



The Allergy Seal of Quality reassures consumers suffering from allergies that the products they buy are safe for them.



For suction systems: the suction must keep 80 % of allergy-causing particles (constantly away from the allergy-affected person).
